The only known hiapo on Niue is now housed in the Niue National Museum. The rare tāoga was gifted by the NZ Minister of Island Affairs, Hon. D. MacIntyre to the Hon. Leader of Government Business, Mr R. R. Rex at the opening of the Niue International Airport, 23rd November 1971. It had graced the Niue Legislative Assembly debating chambers for more than four decades.
